As you are fully aware the 2010 Olympic games have become a contentious issue within the Native world, due to the fact that in order to accommodate the games, native lands have once again been stolen in a racist act of aggression by the Canadian Government.



Therefore, be it known, that should your Government pursue its racist agenda within our communities, then the true people who will resist it cannot be held responsible for defending against "**your**" actions, but that the proper authority within the I.O.C., the Federal and provincial Governments, the R.C.M.P. and any other involved police forces will be held fully responsible for whatever may transpire within Kahnawake, or any Native community that may have this racist poison injected into it.

Stay out of our communities.

Also, any non-Native person who may assist us in facilitating the removal of such poison will be afforded the same right by virtue of invitation.
